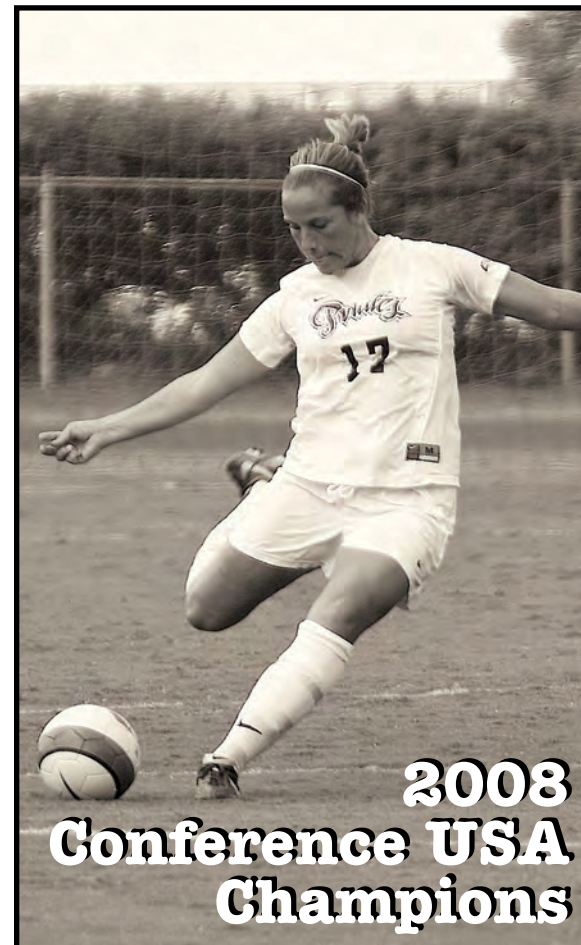

### MEDICAL COVERAGE

All campers must have their own medical coverage. The Rob Donnenwirth Girls' Soccer Camp only provides coverage after your insurance policy has been utilized. ## Features

### STAFF

The coaching staff is comprised of college coaches who have demonstrated an ability to teach the principles of the game. The coach-to-camper ratio will not exceed 1:12. College players will also serve as camp counselors and assistant coaches.

### CAMPER EVALUATION

Each camper will receive a written evaluation detailing the camper's strengths and areas of improvement in the technical, tactical, physical, and psychological dimensions of the game.

### GOALKEEPER SCHOOL

Goalkeepers who attend camp will be trained in the specific areas required for successful goal-keeping. The goalkeeper school is run by a specialized goalkeeper coach and is demanding.

### CAMP BALL

You may purchase a camp ball for \$30 or you may bring your own. All campers must have a ball at each session of the camp. If you would like to purchase a camp ball, please indicate so on your camp application.

## Fees

The camp fee is an all-inclusive fee with the exception of spending money and a refundable \$50 room deposit, which is due at registration. The room deposit will be returned at check-out.
